DECLARATION: YARD SALE AGREEMENT

Persons may engage in the activity of selling goods, wares, or merchandise in residential zones or in areas used for residential purposes in only the manner prescribed herein:

- * The resident shall first obtain a city permit that shall be displayed at the sale site.
- * Such activity shall be conducted within garages, carports, front yards, backyards, patios and walkways, located on the resident's property. NO goods, wares, or merchandise shall be displayed or placed in the public right of way.
- * All such goods wares, and merchandise shall be the PERSONAL property of the resident or his/her sale co-conductors and shall be obsolete to his/her/their use.
- * NO advertising signs shall be posted more than one (1) week PRIOR to the initial sale date. NO such signs shall be posted within the public right-of-way except on self-supporting stakes. The conductors of the sale shall remove all signs immediately at the end of the sale. The activity may only be held between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. for a maximum of three (3) consecutive days.
- * NO more than two (2) yard sales shall be conducted at any one location, within a six (6) month period.
- * There is no charge for the first yard sale of each 12 month period. There will be a cost of \$5.00 for each additional yard sale. NOTE: There are no refunds. Fees paid may be credited to a future date if cancelled due to weather by notification in advance. Call the phone number at the top of this permit to leave a message if cancelling after hours.
- * The provisions of this section shall NOT apply to *churches, public schools, or charitable organizations* if the sale is conducted on the property of the organization and NOT in a private residence. If such sale is conducted in or on the premises of a private residence, all of the provisions in this section shall apply.
- * Violation of any provision of this section is determined to constitute an infraction punishable by a fine NOT exceeding \$100 for a *first* violation, a fine NOT exceeding \$200 for a *second* violation of the same section within one (1) year, and a fine NOT exceeding \$500 for each additional violation of the same section within one (1) year. A *fourth* violation within one (1) year shall constitute a MISDEMEANOR (Ord. 725 § 1, 1993; prior code § 9121.25).
