## Reporting Illicit Discharges

An illicit discharge is anything other than rainwater that is dumped, swept, blown or discharged into a storm drain or water body, which pollutes the Rio Hondo River and downstream waterbodies.

Some examples of illicit discharges include:

- Dirt or sediment from construction sites
- Mop wash water dumped into the street
- Drained pool or hot tub water
- Dumped motor oil in the street
- Dumped household cleaning solutions
